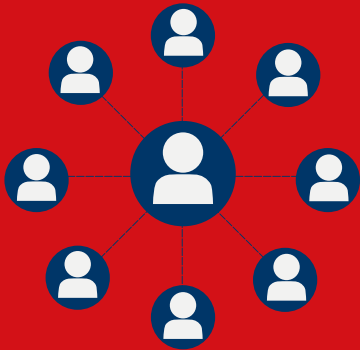


COVID-19 INFO

HOW CONTACT TRACING WORKS



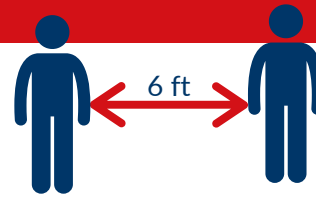
After a person receives a positive test result for COVID-19, contact tracing protocols are enacted. All "close contacts" of the individual are notified and required to quarantine for 14 days at home.

Department of Public Health defines "close contacts" as individuals who were less than six feet away from the person for at least 15 minutes.

This means passing someone in the hallway doesn't necessarily make you a "close contact".

It is important to socially distance as much as possible because you will be required to stay at home if you are identified as a "close contact".

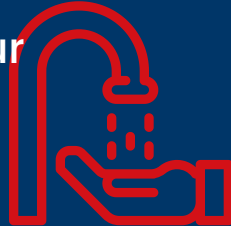
At CCPS, we are using assigned seats in our classrooms in order to expedite contact tracing.

WAYS YOU CAN HELP ENSURE WE STAY IN SCHOOL.

Mask up when social distancing is not possible.

Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.



STAY HOME IF YOU ARE SICK.

If you have any of the following:

- Fever or chills
- Muscle/body aches
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell
